## **IMMLY RELEASE: “Talking Hemp & Cannabis” EXPO” to bring IMMLY to Berlin Wisconsin Sat Feb 6**

**Berlin, WI:** IMMLY’s Jacki Rickert and Gary Storck will be among the featured speakers at the first THC “Talking Hemp & Cannabis” Expo in Berlin, Wisconsin this Saturday Feb 6.

Rickert and Storck will join others helping to bring the discussion about legislation now before the legislature this session covering both hemp farming and medical cannabis to rural Wisconsin. Wisconsin’s Jacki Rickert Medical Marijuana Act will be a major focus of the medical end of the discussion.

Asked what she hopes to see accomplished through the Expo, Jacki Rickert said, “Dialogue. People having their voices heard, speaking with people, not at them. This event will open a lot of minds to the reality that this issue affects everyone at one time another.” Gary Storck noted that “This event will help educate rural Wisconsin not only about the benefits of cannabis, but also give them the tools to let their lawmakers know that this issue is health care and very important to the people of our state, whether rural, or urban”.

IMMLY is honored that Mieko Hester Perez, a California woman who found medical cannabis legally available under a doctor’s care in her state a lifesaving treatment for her autistic son, who at 10 years old weighed only 48 pounds. With doctor-monitored access under California state law, her son gained weight, improved behavior problems and eliminated 10 of 13 prescription medications he had previously been using. Hester Perez’s story has been featured in the media on The Doctors, Good Morning America and ABC News.
